In 2011, Darwin launched Insitu Power Corporation along with Colette Chekerda, which focused on development of on-site generation and asset optimization for industrial consumers. Darwin and Colette now own and operate Carmal Energy Advisors, with a focus on self-retail, strategic procurement, and reporting services for larger industrial and institutional consumers.
